4. These shares are owned directly by CHP II, L.P. ("CHP"). The general partner of CHP is CHP II Management, LLC ("CHP Management"). The managing members of CHP Management, John Clarke, Brandon Hull and John Park, are deemed to have voting and dispositive power over the shares and may be deemed to beneficially own certain shares held by CHP. Each Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership of these securities, except to the extent of his pecuniary interest therein, and this report shall not be deemed an admission that such Reporting Persons are the beneficial owners of such securities for Section 16 or any other purpose
